The Global Village is a unique internship program for teaching conversational English, Spanish, Chinese, German, Russian, Portuguese, Japanese or French to DKU students. Participants will lead small groups in daily language classes for three weeks before continuing onto the Academic Program.

This is a great opportunity to develop friendships with DKU students and gain insight into Korean culture from personal experiences. Also through teaching, you will gain valuable personal insights about yourself!

Qualification

- Undergraduate or graduate students fluent in speaking one or more of the listed languages.
- Applications are only open to students participating the Academic Program.

Application/Selection Process

- ① Complete online application
- ② Send additional application documents to iss@dankook.ac.kr
 - Letter of Recommendation (from faculty members)
 - Personal Essay (500-600 words on your participation in the GV)
- ③ After an initial screening process of a student's application, an online interview might be arranged
- ④ Acceptance results will be announced by March 9, 2018
- ⑤ Accepted students need to confirm and return the acceptance offer by March 16, 2018

Benefits

- Flight reimbursement up to USD1000 (for teaching two sessions) upon successful completion of the Global Village.
 - If the airfare is less than USD1000, the student will receive the airfare total listed on their receipt.
- Internship Certificate of Achievement
- Free on-campus accommodation during the GV period

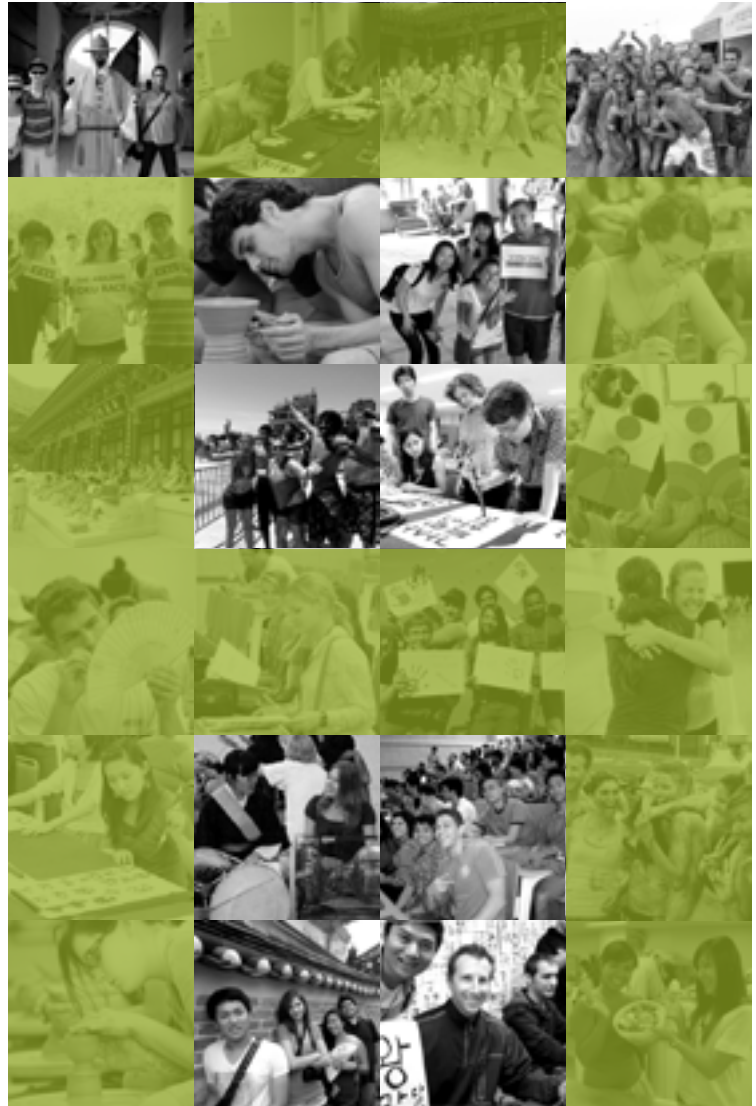
GV Schedule

- Period June 19 ~ July 6, 2018 (3 weeks)
- Arrival June 18, 2018 (designated arrival/dorm move-in date)
- Orientation June 19 ~ 20, 2018
 - » Students will be given an information package containing materials for class instruction, books to use in class, a schedule, grading standards, etc.
- Classes June 21 ~ July 6, 2018
- Sessions 2.5hours x 2sessions daily x 12days (Monday to Friday)
 - » Morning Session 9:30am ~ 12:00pm
 - » Afternoon Session 1:30pm ~ 4:00pm
- Teaching 5hours a day - total 60hours of teaching

Important Notice

- All GV participants must attend the Academic Program (AP).
- If a student decides not to go onto the AP after completion of the GV, the student will not receive any benefits associated with GV participation.
- Participants will be assigned randomly either at the Jukjeon or Cheonan campus.
- Orientation is mandatory for all participants.

Course Detail

- Course Dates Monday through Thursday, no classes on Fridays, 4days/week
- Course Times Morning Class 9:00am ~ 12:00pm / Afternoon Class 1:00pm ~ 4:00pm
- Course Hours 3hours/day x 15days = 45hours/course
- Lecture Topics East Asian Studies, Business, Economics, Social Sciences, IT, Communications, Global Issues, History, Fashion, Theatre Arts, Tourism, Korean Language, etc.

- Students can take up to 2 courses; 3 credits per course.
- To transfer credits, students are advised to consult with an academic advisor at their home university and obtain pre-approval to receive credits for coursework from DKU.

Optional Cultural Activities & Field Trips

- Activities Ceramic art, Calligraphy, Korean traditional music, Korean traditional dance, making kimchi, Taekwondo, nonverbal musical, DMZ tour, Temple Stay, Mud Festival, visit to a Korean company Visit, Folk Village, amusement park, etc.
- Students can select activities during the application period and pay for the selected activities at the orientation.

Credits

- Upon participation in over 70% of the cultural activities and field trips, students can receive 3 credits for Korean Culture Studies.
- To transfer credits, students are advised to consult with an academic advisor at their home university and obtain pre-approval to receive credits for coursework from DKU.
